The project's duration is 2 years (starting on 1st April 2018 and ending on 31st March 2020) and will be supported by **Discover Dunblane BID** and other key stakeholders.

The post-holder will support and mentor young people in identifying employability opportunities (including business start-up), develop a network of opportunities with businesses and third sector organisations both within and outwith Dunblane and critically embed sustainable practices within the project.

You should be educated to degree level and ideally hold an educational qualification in advice or guidance. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills are essential, as well as strong organisational and presentation skills. It is essential that the applicant has a good knowledge of the Dunblane business community as well as BIDs (Business Improvement Districts). The applicant must also have an up to date knowledge of education including the Wood Commission report, Government employee strategy, and experience of mentoring young people.
